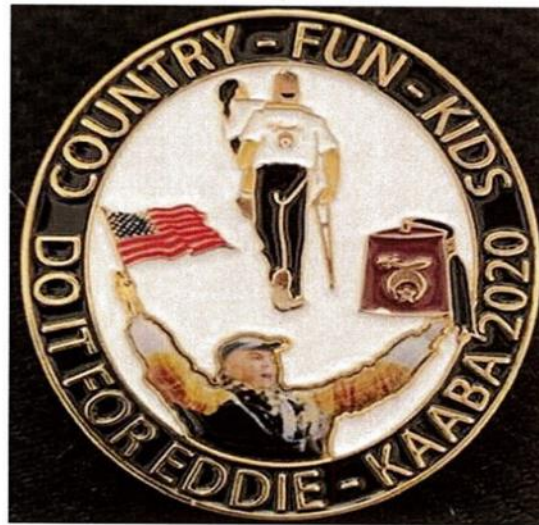

Masonic Charity

One of the first acts of Masonic Charity to occur in the American Civil War was at The First Battle of Manassas or Bull Run on July 21st, 1861.

Colonel W.H. Raynor of the 1st Ohio left his command and in the company of two Sergeants went to fetch water at a nearby creek. Suddenly, as they neared the stream, they heard loud yells that eventually became known as the "Rebel Yell" and the thundering hoofs of hundreds of horses. Colonel Raynor instinctively raised his pistol just as buckshot hit the instep of his foot and numbed it. Finding a large tree nearby he dropped to his knees and watched the battle rage around him. A Rebel horseman fired his pistol at Raynor and missed, then as he passed, struck Raynor with his saber in the head. Lights flashed through Raynor's brain and he fell senseless looking almost dead.

After a period of time Raynor, becoming slightly conscious and realized that someone was tugging at his clothes. Bewildered he leaned upon one elbow and realized that a Rebel was stripping the dead. He already had taken Raynor's pistol, sword, canteen and cap and was trying to remove his coat. The robber, being startled at the resurrection of the man he was trying to rob, jumped on his horse and rode off.

Later coming completely to his senses, Raynor realized he was surrounded by the Confederate Calvary. Two calvarymen seeing him standing, grabbed him between their horses and dragged him off a considerable distance. Finally one lifted him and placed him front of him on his horse. They rode till they came to a group of Rebel wounded. There he was placed on the ground and a group gathered around him cursing and calling him names. Being weak from the loss of blood and in considerable pain, he just laid back and ignored them. His being quiet caused even more of a commotion to the point one angry Confederate fired his pistol at Raynor but missed. Then the Southerners argued over the cowardly act. By this time, Raynor had almost wished that the ball had pierced his brain.

It was now early evening and the Southern wounded from the front were being treated at the junction in a stable. Raynor was taken first to a surgeon who refused to treat him because he was a Yankee and who said that he had enough to take care of from his own army. Finally another more compassionate surgeon was found and his wounds were treated. He was made as comfortable as possible. His guard, J.H. Lemon of Radford's Calvary truly acted the part of the good *Samaritan*. Lemon somewhere found ice and put it on the pounding head of Raynor and inquired if Raynor needed any money.

In response to Raynor's expression of gratitude and pointing to his Masonic pin on Raynor's shirt, Lemon replied, "I can only hope to get the same treatment from your men if I ever fall into their hands. If you relieve the distress of a suffering Brother Mason when in your power. I shall be well paid." Lemon then mounted his horse and rode away.

Many years later Colonel Raynor, would be asked who helped save him during the war and his reply would always be, "**His name was Hiram.**"

Attached is a letter that a current patient of the Shriners Hospital Portland wrote and sent to the Hospital this past week. It is such a moving letter that I asked the Hospital Administrator if we could share the letter with all our Shrine Masons. Our Administrator checked with the family and they gave the OK to share this amazing letter.

The letter shows the quality of care the Portland hospital provides and the level of expertise our Doctors provide over non-Shrine Doctors. Feel free to share this letter with family and friends and let them know the quality of care Shriners Hospitals for Children – Portland provided for kids in Oregon and the Pacific Northwest.

June 2, 2020

Dear Shriners,

Almost 3 years ago to the date, we stumbled upon your hospital after months of confusion as to why our seemingly healthy three year old daughter was limping. After being told by several doctors that it was anything from a sprained ankle to leukemia, we finally had a diagnosis of fibrous dysplasia. The doctor we met with (at a different hospital) was kind, but uninformed. My mom mentioned a distant family member being a Shriner and since we lived in Portland, we should check it out. Our first appointment at The Shriners Hospital for Children was first class. From the parking garage to the xrays and the snacks in the hall, the experience was something to write home about. Dr. Roy was extremely knowledgeable about her condition and set our worried hearts at ease. (our daughter's)

Fast forward 3 years and here we are, inpatient with our ^{now} 6 year old daughter who is recovering from a surgery by Dr. Bauer. I remain just as impressed today as I was at her very first appointment.

Let me back up a little though. No one wants to be in need of medical attention ever, let alone during a world pandemic with much changing every single day. I reached back out to Shriners in February following a June 2019 all clear appointment. I noticed a new limp, but this time, we lived in Arizona, not in Oregon. Where do you go when your child has a rare bone condition? To the very best of course. Shriners is always worth the trip. We got some scans in Arizona and were ready to travel for an appointment with Dr. Roy. Two days

before our flight, Dr. Roy personally called me to say that things were quickly changing and I may need to get an opinion from Phoenix Children's Hospital. So we did. The doc confirmed a need for surgery and understood if we'd rather go to Shriners. Suddenly all elective surgeries were cancelled everywhere. In the midst of the waiting, we spoke to care managers and changed our daughter's doctor from Roy to Bauer. With still no date for surgery, Dr. Bauer personally called me to talk through a tentative plan.

We finally got a call for surgery dates, plans for travel, and now here we are recovering in one of the best hospitals I've experienced (and with 5 kids, I've seen a few).

There have been no egos to fuel; just my daughter's care. ^{at the forefront.} The people I met at her preop appointment are the same people we have seen during our stay. The nurses and aides are excellent across the board. PT is amazing. The cafeteria is attentive and quick.

Most of all though, I'd wait longer and travel more to experience the level of care we have. Dr. Bauer and Dr. Roy made decisions just prior to surgery that I can trust and appreciate. I would have second guessed it had I stayed in Arizona. Their level of expertise and motivation will have us singing the praises of Shriners Hospitals for Children for years to come. Thank you for giving so much. We are reaping the benefits of what you have sewn in.
