Hospital Notes from Shriners Children's Chicago, 25 Feb 2025

Over the past year I have informed you about what is going on at the Shriners Children's Chicago during each Kaaba Stated Meeting.

The Hospital received five prestigious Human Experience awards for 2024: four Press Ganey Guardian of Excellence Awards. They are (1) Patient Experience, (2) Inpatient Pediatric, (3) Physical Experience-Academic, (4) Patient Experience, and one Pinnacle of Excellence award for exceptional care within the hospital for (5) Children Healthcare. The Press Ganey Guardian of Excellence Awards were from surveys completed by families of the patients.

Shriners Children's has been named the top Midsized Employer for 2025 by Forbes and Statistica Inc. This prestigious recognition comes from a survey the organizations have been conducting and publishing for the past 10 years. Being ranked Number 1 on America's Best Midsize Employers list also means that Shriners Children's is recognized as the leader in the Healthcare & Social Services industry category.

From the annual report, progress was made on the previous year goals and objectives. New patients and outpatient clinic volumes exceeded projected numbers for 2024, which should lead to a strong 2025.

Project 2035 is now referred to a Compass 2035. Back when Project 2035 was first introduced there were goals set, as of today several of those goals have been completed and some refinement in others have been established. So therefore, a name change was in order. Four categories of Compass 2035 are More Kids, which is finding new and unique patients, More Value, which is using Utilization of Resources, Best Care, which is using the experience of the staff, and More Value, which is using utilization of resources.

The Master Facility projects that are still being worked on include the MRI/CT where the drawing has been finalized with the vendor and the Transportation and Lodging Assistance Policy that is being reviewed and awaiting system policy approval to start the action plan. The first Illinois clinic, Central Illinois Clinic, is targeted for 26 March 2025 with a Chicago provided physician in the 2nd and 4th Quarter of 2025. The 100th Anniversary of SCH will be some time in 2026. A committee has been appointed with more information to come.

The hospital has implemented the Compass Rose Youth Adult Transition Program in June 2024 to assist patients from youth into adult care. Not every patient will complete their surgeries and/or care before they age out of the Shriners Children's system and this program helps them deal with the transition. To date some 89 patients have signed up for this program. Chicago has cared for 69 patients from over 22 different countries and are still caring for more kids from outside our borders. SHC has expanded nursing students' rotations from DePaul, University of Illinois and other college locations. SHC is fully staffed with RNs for the first time since COVID.

Chicago statistics for January 2025 are: Surgeries: 90 of which 8 were spine and 56 being outpatients' surgeries. On-site visits number was 1,559. Telehealth was 26, and new patients were 224. Operation expenses for January was \$4,365,417 that is just shy of 200K per day. The donation goal for 2025 if seven (7) million dollars. It is never too late to make a donation to your Mid-West Market hospital system.

The Chicago Hospital has lost 1employee during the month of January, with a turnover rate of 0.03%. At the present time we have 381 employees on staff with very few openings available.

The 2024 "Watch Me" campaign is over. The new campaign is "Empowering The Extraordinary". There will be at least 5 different ads aired, so look for them. The title of them will be "Innovators in Sports Injury, Leaders in Pediatric Hand Care, Innovators in Physical Therapy, Innovators in Complex Wound and Skin Conditions and Leaders in Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services". Look for them on Facebook, Instagram, TV or other places you see your social media and share with your friends.

Our plant and facilities are doing a good job in maintaining the building and grounds. On-going projects include the 2024 Capital Surgeries Doors replacement that is scheduled to start on 24 March and be completed 4 days later, maintenance team must install I/C barriers in accordance with ICCR regulations. An I/C Barrier is a dust barrier to prevent dust and debris from entering the operation rooms. An engineering company was called in to assess the plumbing and boiler piping, with several additional pipes being added as the building expanded. The engineers are evaluating how to maintain the building without major overhaul of plumbing. The five (5) annual inspections of the fire sprinklers and water pipes are due. Code and inspection procedures have changed, therefore, awaiting outcome of the inspection.
