



Life is a story in volumes three, the past, the present, the yet to be.



Hospital Notes from Chicago Children Hospital

Lady Mary and I attended the Screening Clinic Workshop November 21, 2024 at Shriners Children's St Louis in MO., where we were provided information on how screening clinics should be conducted. A lot of information was provided with some things pointed out as necessary to be successful in completing each clinic, such as to have a committee chairman to direct the clinic and good volunteers willing to pitch in and help. One of the handouts was "Shrine Temple" Shriners Hospital Prescreening Clinic Guidelines. This will be made available to anyone willing to take on the task of becoming the Clinic Coordinator. I believe that every Club or Unit should have a screening coordinator that will take the lead and become part of the Kaaba team to help fine new patients. Is this person, YOU?

Chicago statistics for the 23 operational days in October, 2024 are: Surgeries: 101 with 11 being spine and 56 being outpatients' surgeries totaling 21,204 minutes of surgeries. On-site visits number was 1,882. SHC saw 250 new patients and rehabilitation provided services to 1,618 patients. The average length of stay was 4.39 days. Cost per adjusted patient day is \$8,223.00.

The Chicago hospital has lost 0 personnel in October, 2024. Several new hires are expected over the up-coming months.

In the Marketing and Communication area: Halloween is a big deal for the Chicago location, with patients, staff and volunteers decorating and in costumes, and using pumpkins to make everyone feel like they did not miss the holiday fun. A pumpkin decorating contest was also conducted with several available for judging.

The 2024 "Watch Me" campaign will have television, OTT (over the top) and digital streaming TV, Facebook, Instagram, Tik Tok, YouTube. One will see advertising with "The Most Amazing Care Anywhere" as the main slogan. This will be available in handout and digital marketing form, so spread this image by means of using your digital devices and share with your friends.

Our plant and facilities are doing a good job in maintaining the building and grounds. On-going projects include the operating door at the surgical room, steam trap replacement, roof replacement, frequencies drives, boiler #3's burner replacement, automatic door at dock area. Sealing and striping the parking lot has been completed and looks good. This job will help preserve the parking lot from future damage.


