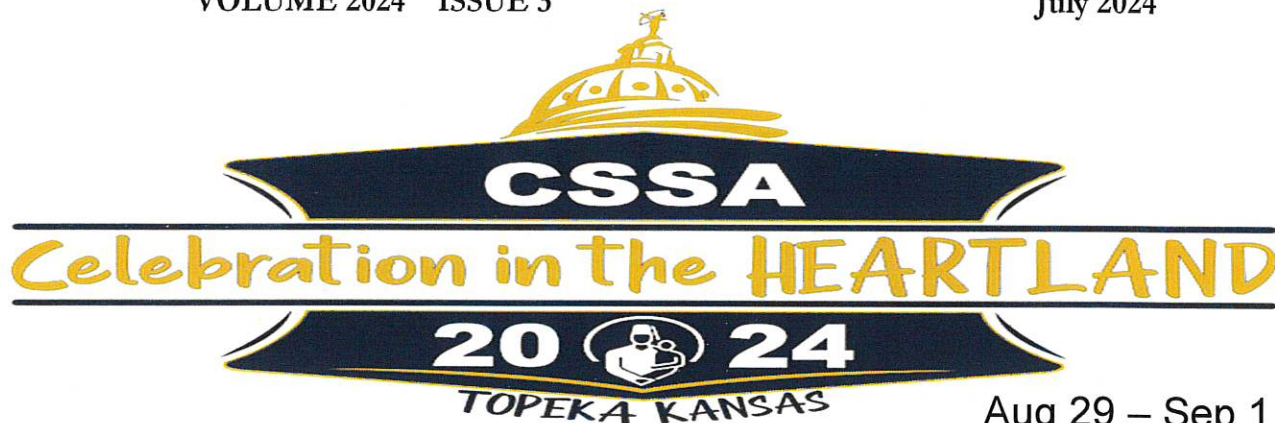

## **The Ottumwa Shrine Club Surprised Five-Year-Old Natalie Brown with Gait Trainer**

On Friday, June 28, 2024, the Ottumwa Shrine Club surprised five-year-old Natalie Brown, diagnosed with Microcephaly, with a pink gait trainer necessary for her strength, walking, and coordination development at the Jimmy Jones Memorial Shelter in Greater Ottumwa Park. Natalie's family was financially unable to purchase this item. They made several attempts to get this item through insurance but were repeatedly redented. After trying to get other help, the Ottumwa Shrine Club was contacted to possibly help her with securing the gait trainer.

The Ottumwa Shrine Club coordinated with the local NuCara Home medical office, and they offered to drop the trainer to cost, but it was still very expensive- \$4,500. Kaaba Shrine, the Grand Masonic Lodge of Iowa, and both of our local Masonic lodges - Empire Lodge # 269 and Ottumwa Lodge #16 made up the difference and purchased the device.

She joyfully scooted around the pavilion after NuCara adjusted the device as Shriners, Masons, family, and supporters watched. Thanks to Warehouse BBQ who provided the meal. We are so proud to make a local impact on Natalie and do what Shriners do- help kids with pediatric development and physical needs.

JBS and Warehouse BBQ donated a pork BBQ dinner for all in attendance afterwards. DJ entertainment with music and a Light show was provided by the Ottumwa Shrine Club.

The Ottumwa Shrine Club is a local club of Nobles from of the Kaaba Shrine, headquartered in Davenport, part of Shriners International.

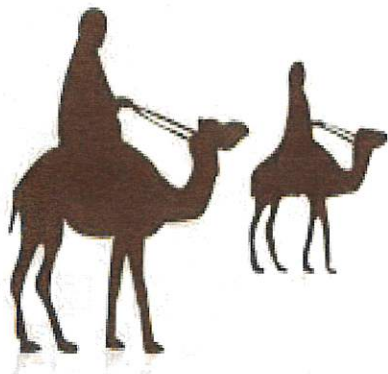

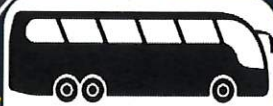

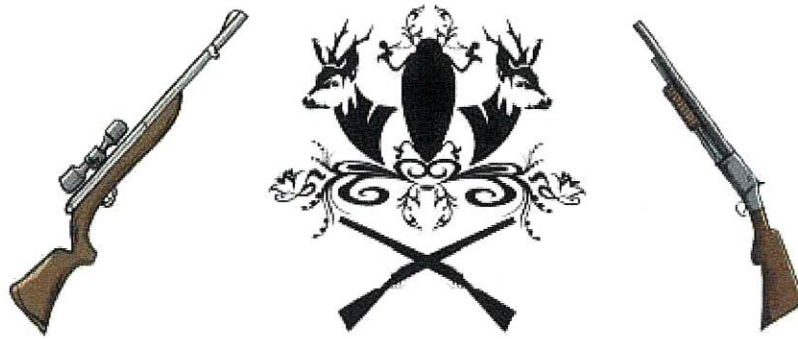
